





TIPS & TRICKS

RESEARCH, RESEARCH, RESEARCH

- Tons of resources available
- Look at as much as you can before you start writing the grant
- Check for previous recipients.

WRITING

- Multiple drafts
- Co-worker input & revisions
- Grant writing team
- Use boldface and italics to make key terms stand out
- Keep it simple but entertaining

PROOFREAD, THEN PROOFREAD AGAIN

- Seriously
- Check deadlines & submission requirements

APPLICATION PARTS

- B. Narrative: Address each topic below. Limit to three (3) pages.
 - 1. Describe your project, including the needs and issues to be addressed; major activities; and target audience.

The library is requesting funding to help complete a History of the Vice Presidency exhibit that would be displayed in the library during summer 2016 into fall 2016 and possibly beyond. This idea was sparked by Longwood University receiving the bid for the 2016 Vice Presidential debate. The major activity would be the physical exhibits that will be designed and researched by Greenwood library staff and librarians as well as Longwood students. We hope that with this exhibit we will be able to engage the 30,000+ students that come to the library every semester.

APPLICATION PARTS

C. Budget: Please prepare a budget for your grant proposal showing planned expenses in as much detail as possible.

Note: The ADP does not pay for food served at receptions or equipment already owned by Longwood University.

Total requested: \$6000

\$5000 – 10 Square-Off Retractable Banner (from 4imprint, documentation in section D.) includes estimated shipping costs.

\$600 - copyright & reproduction rights fees (documentation in section D.)

\$400 – other fees for printing or unexpected set up fees.
